(An applicant in the first year of any public tertiary institution in Ghana and should have credit passes subjects with overall aggregate of **24** at the **WASSCE/SSSCE** respectively).

Three of the six subjects should be core subjects: English Language, Mathematics, Integrated Science

**Studies** and three must be in relevant electives.

For the purposes of this Scholarship, a credit pass in:

i. WASSCE means A1 – C6

ii. SSSCE means A – D

AND

A continuing student applicant should have a minimum **GPA of 3.0** and should provide a stamped trans from the university attended.

- **b)** Be involved in extra curricula activities.
- **c)** Be proven to be without any academic disciplinary issue and/or must not be serving a bond to be of behaviour.
